ARTWORK AT HOME National Artwork Competition - Terms and Conditions

1. Longton Property Group proudly hosts a national artwork competition with a theme of creative artwork and decoration pieces for contemporary Australian apartments.
2. The competition is open to all art students in Australia. Employees of Longton Property Group or any person associated with the competition and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.

8. Dimension restriction applies to all the artwork submitted.
 - Two dimensional pieces up to 4m (width) * 2m (height)
 - Three dimensional pieces up to 2m (height) * 1.5m (width) * 1m (depth)
9. The judging panel will select the winning artwork based on the following criteria:
 - How well the piece relates to the theme
 - Aesthetic and artistic appeal
 - Creativity
 - Originality
