

Artwork at Home National Artwork Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. Longton Property proudly hosts a national artwork competition with a theme of creative artwork and decoration pieces for contemporary Australian apartments.

2. The competition is open to all fine art students in Australia. Employees of Longton or any person associated with the competition and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.

3. The competition is open to any form of artwork. The mediums include but are not limited to paintings, drawings, sculptures and photographs. All entries should be accompanied by a synopsis no more than 500 words.

4. The competition commences at 9am, 1 March 2013 and closes at 5pm, 1 August 2013.

5. Longton Property will offer the following three prizes to the winners.

- One Grand Prize: AUD3,000;
- Two Second Prizes: AUD1,000 each, and
- Three Third Prizes: AUD500 each.

Award winning artists may be also entitled to a long term artwork engagement by Longton Property.

6. The awards will be announced on 1 September 2013.

7. Dimension restriction applies to all the artwork submitted.

- Two dimensional pieces up to 4m (width) * 2m (height)
- Three dimensional pieces up to 2m (height) * 1.5m (width) * 1m (depth)

8. The judging panel will select the winning artwork based on the following criteria:

- How well the piece relates to the theme
- Aesthetic and artistic appeal
- Creativity
- Originality

9. All entrants shall submit their artwork to the following addresses:

10. Entrants are responsible for paying the costs of transporting the work to the organiser.

- Artwork Title
- A synopsis no more than 500 words

Entrants' personal details will only be used by Longton Property for future contact.

12. Multiple entries are allowed in this competition.

13. The entrant represents and warrants that the work is the entrant's sole original work. Longton does not tolerate plagiarising, copying or tracing existing artworks.

14. Entrants consent to any infringements of their moral rights by the organiser. Entrants consent to the organiser using their name, biographical details and likeness in connection with the competition.

15. Longton Property reserves all rights with regards to this competition. All pieces of art submitted to the competition may be used for future promotional activities by Longton Property. All entries will be required to agree to future use of their art. Once the artwork is rendered for the participation, the author surrenders all ownership and intellectual property rights associated with or arising from the artwork.
